THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- * Be positive give positive reinforcement to the group
- * Be energetic
- * Background give context to what you are teaching and why you are teaching it
- * Break up larger sections into smaller more accessible chunks
- * Give the words (handouts/powerpoint/etc)
- * Choose your words carefully
- * Use instruments appropriately remember that your voice is the most important instrument in your teach
- * Make the space you are in engaging
- * Be humble and relatable
- * Stay calm! Relax!
- * Making mistakes (big and little) is OK
- * Don't be afraid to stop and get pronunciation or melody right!

- 3. Break Grabber (depend song/age group)
- 4. Sing Grabber together

- 7. Sing Verse together
- 8. Sing Grabber and Verse
- 9. Extras
 - 1. Harmonies
 - 2. Handmotions
 - 3. Claps
