HOW TO INTERACT WITH CLERGY

- * Combine your customs and their customs.
- * Understand the needs of multiple communities.
- * Treat others with respect.
- * Utilize all tools available to you.

THINGS TO REMEMBER WHEN WORKING WITH CLERGY

- * They might have a different set of goals than you do.
- * They serve a different community than you do.
- * They have typically been service leading a lot longer than you.
- * They appreciate when you show professionalism and respect for the work itself.
- * Show respect and you shall receive respect.
- * They are an unbelievable resource - use them.

HOW TO INTERACT WITH REGIONAL BOARD (SPECIFICALLY RCVPs)

- * Treat others with respect.
- * Use all tools available to you.
- * Communicate clear expectations.
- * The value of debriefing.

THINGS TO REMEMBER WHEN WORKING WITH REGIONAL BOARD

- * Communication is the key to success.
- * Define clear goals so everyone is on the same page.
- * Your RCVPs (and the rest of Regional Board) are incredible resources - use them.
- * Show respect and you shall receive respect.

- * You are on the same team.
